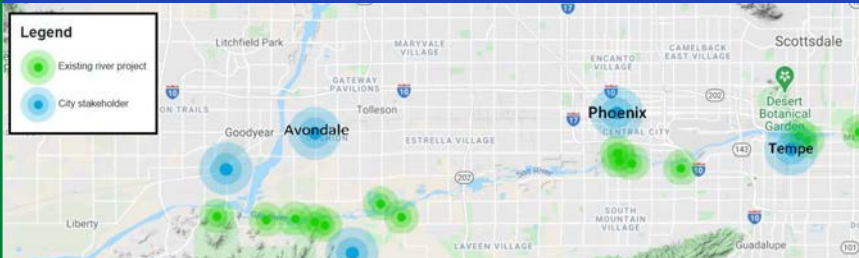

- Clean-up alternatives analysis
- Remediation planning documents

RIO REIMAGINED BROWNFIELDS REDEVELOPMENT

Brownfields land recycling is the development of vacant or underutilized properties that are not being developed because of contamination or the perception of contamination on the site.

ELIGIBILITY

- A site that has actual or perceived environmental issues that is not in active use
- Within 1 mile of the Salt, Gila or Agua Fria Rivers in Avondale, Phoenix or Tempe
- Plan for redevelopment of the site
- Contamination not caused by owner of the site
- Consistency with the City's General Plan, community vision, and City Initiatives, including Rio Reimagined, Food Systems Goals, etc.
- Potential for leveraged funding

Rio Reimagined is a movement sparked by the late Senator McCain to transform the Rio Salado into a unifying public space that enhances social equity. This redevelopment goal integrates the priorities of public open space, environmental quality, housing, transportation, economic and workforce development, community sustainability and resilience.

This grant is a coalition of the Cities of Avondale, Phoenix and Tempe with partner ASU, and will support redevelopment of Brownfield properties within the Rio Reimagined corridor.
